Additionally, these children attend schools without the basic supplies that they need to be able to learn the necessary skills for a successful future career. I encourage you to help these children by donating new and used school supplies, clothing, and shoes. The following is a list of the most needed items.

School supplies:

- ★ pencils
- ★ pens (blue, black, and red)
- ★ crayons
- ★ markers
- ★ rulers
- ★ erasers
- ★ scissors
- ★ glue/glue sticks (new glue only please)
- ★ folders
- ★ binders
- ★ protractors
- ★ compasses
- ★ math flash cards
- ★ Spanish children's books and materials
- ★ highlighters
- ★ craft supplies (popsicle sticks, yarn, pipe cleaners, etc.)
- ★ science equipment



Clothing/Shoes:

- ★ warm weather clothes (shorts, t-shirts, etc.)
- ★ jeans
- ★ all types of shoes (especially closed-toe shoes suitable for walking/working outdoors)

*** Please do not send materials in English, winter coats, boots, etc. The majority of the students do not know any English and the tropical climate does not permit the use of winter wear. ☺*
